

## **PROGRAM OVERVIEW**

The UCCS BA in IECE program is pleased to announce a new ECE Apprenticeship opportunity, funded through the CO Department of Early Childhood. This program will fund 12 participants to simultaneously complete two years of IECE coursework leading to a BA in IECE (ECE and ECSE license) while working in a licensed child care program (school district preschool, Head Start, etc.). Federally-registered apprenticeships are a nationally-recognized work-based learning model that provides workers with job experience, mentorship, supportive services, and wage increases for credential and degree attainment.

## For Employer Partners:

- Financial support for hosting apprentices
- Stipends to support apprentice bonuses
- Financial support for substitutes
- Stipends for mentor teachers

# For Apprentices:

- Full tuition and fee coverage for 2 full-time years of courses
- Job embedded coaching
- Bonuses for credits and experience
- Qualification for CDE teaching credentials: ECE and ECSE
- Continued ECE employment for 2 years during the program
